Category Criteria

1. Outstanding New or Reconstructed Short Span(s) Bridges

- Single span or multi-span structure where longest individual span length is less than or equal to 100'

2. Outstanding New or Reconstructed Medium Span(s) Bridges

- Single span or multi-span structure where longest individual span length is greater than 100' but less than or equal to 250'

3. Outstanding New or Reconstructed Long Span(s) Bridges

- Single span or multi-span structure where longest individual span length is greater than 250'

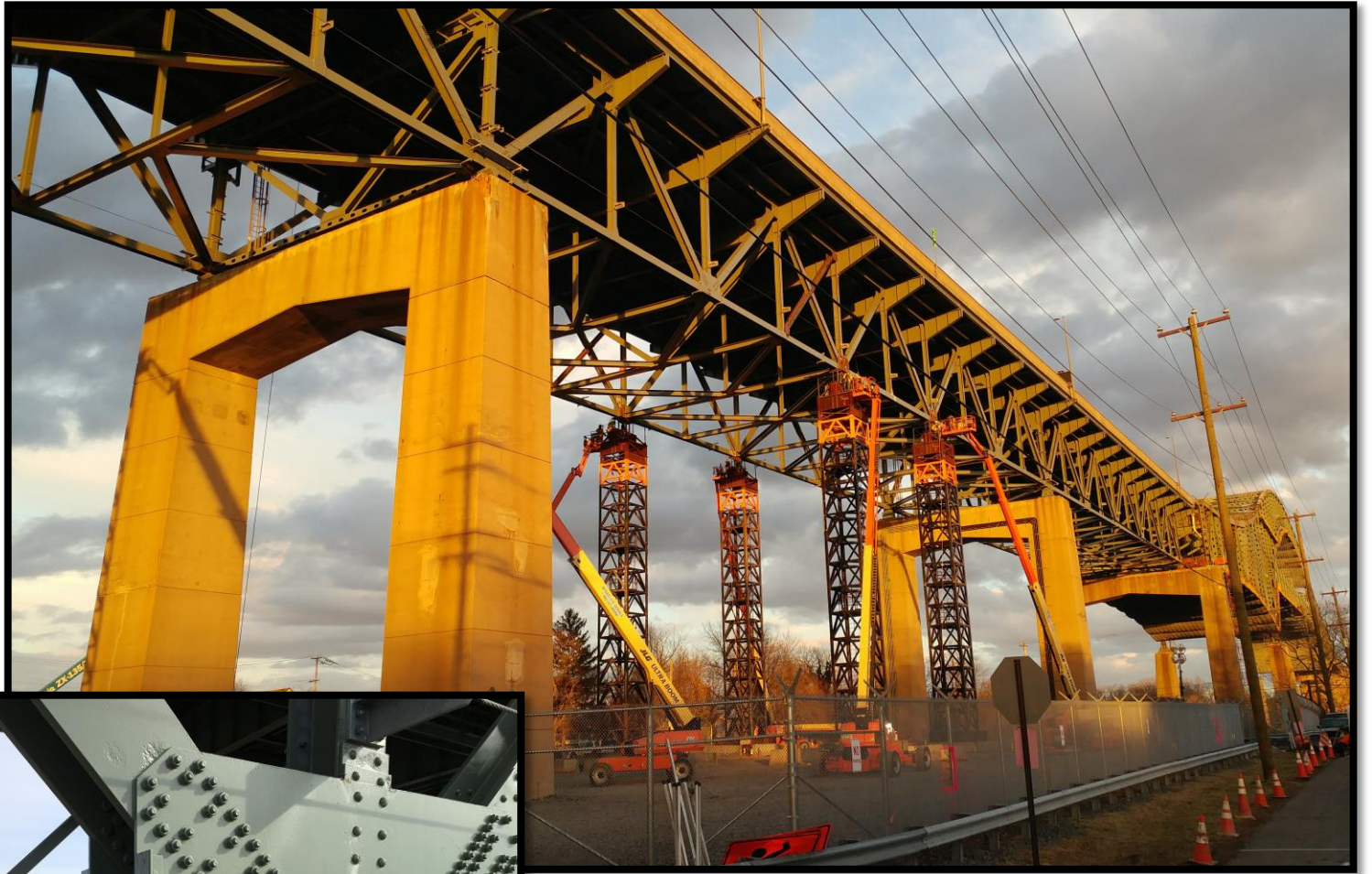
4. Outstanding Rehabilitated Bridges

- Main load carrying members must be retained (All span lengths apply)

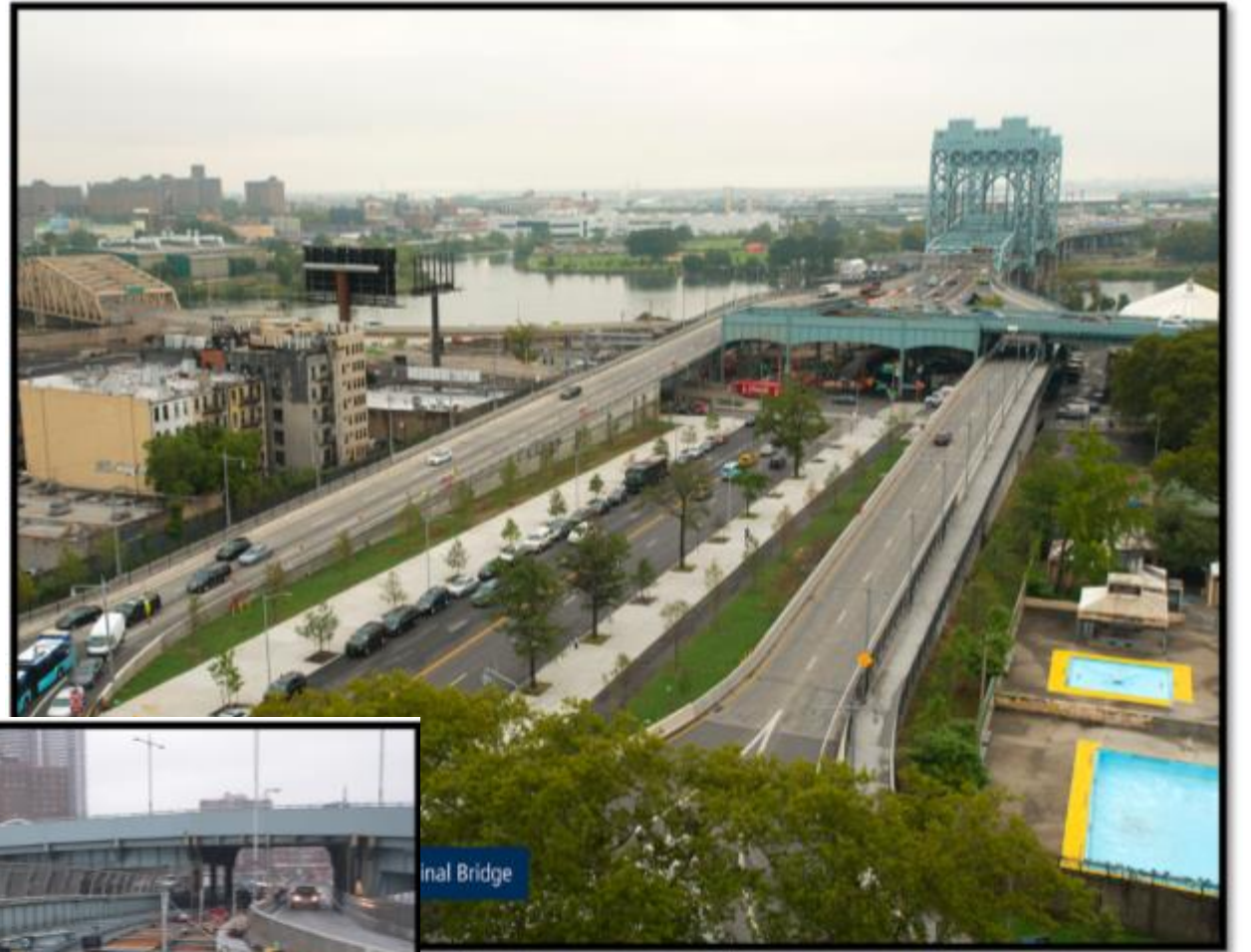

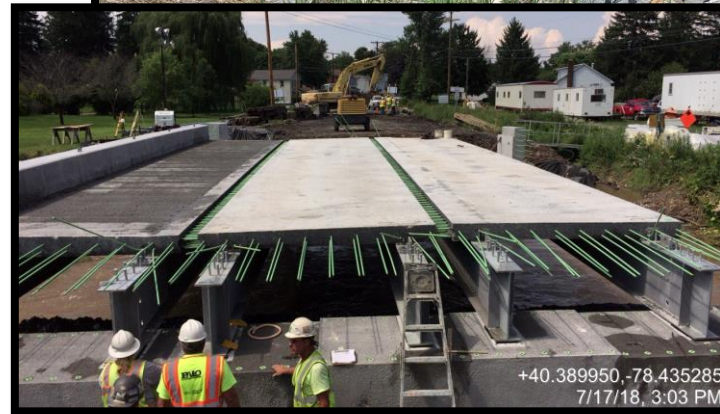
